2006/2007 CLEARANCE OF NEWLY ADMITTED STUDENTS

The 2006/2007 Online Clearance Exercise for newly admitted candidates commences on **Monday 11th December, 2006**. The exercise ends on **Friday 22nd December, 2006**.

Procedure for Clearance:

Candidates are expected to launch into Uniben Website – <http://uniben.waeup.org> (free of charge) to check their PUME results.

Only admitted candidates should proceed with a **₦250**-Admission-Checking Scratch Card to confirm their admission details. Each candidate should print his/her admission slip.

Each admitted student should purchase a **₦10,500**-Clearance-Scratch-Card that is required for filling the clearance/eligibility form online from the following banks:

1. Intercontinental Bank, Ugbowo Campus, Uniben
2. Unity Bank, Ugbowo Campus, Uniben
3. UBA, UBTH, Benin City
4. UBA, Ugbowo, Benin City
5. First Bank, Ugbowo, Benin City.
6. Zenith Bank, Akpakpava Road, Benin City.
7. Equatorial Trust Bank, Mission Road, Benin City.
8. Wema Bank, Mission Road, Benin City.
9. First City Monument Bank, Ugbowo, Benin City

On completion of online clearance form filling, candidates are expected to submit online and proceed to their respective faculty for physical clearance by their faculty clearance officer.

6 copies of each of the following items are required as well as their originals for sighting:

- Colour Passport Photograph with red background
- Self Address and Stamped Envelope
- Guarantor's Letter
- Acceptance Letter
- Age Declaration/Birth Certificate
- JAMB Result Slip
- O/Level Results
- Evidence of Change of Name, if any
- PUME Acknowledgement Card
- PUME Result Slip
- Admission Slip

All admitted candidates are advised to start their online clearance immediately to avoid problems.
